NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2009-12 including Appendix D - Team Racing Rules, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ISSA Procedural Rules, the rules of the CFJ and 420 classes, and this Notice of Race (except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY

Teams shall be members of ISSA, currently registered with NWISA, with dues paid and registration forms filed with the NWISA District Representative of ISSA, Burke Thomas. All competitors must be members of their high school sailing team and currently eligible to participate in high school sports based on their high school's regulations.

A fee of \$45 per team will be charged during registration. Entry fee includes a BBQ lunch on Saturday and Sunday for 9 competitors and one coach. Checks can be made out to "Sail Sand Point". Additional lunch tickets can be purchased for \$5.

BOATS

Sail Sand Point will provide a fleet of 12 FJ's for the varsity event. Sail Sand Point will also provide a fleet of 6 FJ's to be used for JV competition.
